


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"The Science of Today is the Technology of Tomorrow"

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



Webinar on parenting

This seminar took place successfully. Huge number of parents wants that school management organise such events for children's growth, in future also.












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Creative Writing

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


Webinar for Teachers

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
Cleanliness Drive











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Virtual PTM

Modern society is based on people who have high living standards and knowledge which allows them to implement better solutions to their problems.


Education in modern society is the form of learning whereby students are taught and equipped with knowledge and skills that will enable them deal with the issues of the present world.
