on this occasion the chairman congratulated the participants and appreciated the parents for putting in extra efforts to develop their Ward's hidden potential.







The Cambridge international school, Gurdaspur celebrated Father's Day. The students made cards for their father and presented it to them.







The cambridge international school had conducted the online activity for the classes I & II and students participated with full enthusiasm.






