INTER HOUSE DEBATE COMPETITION

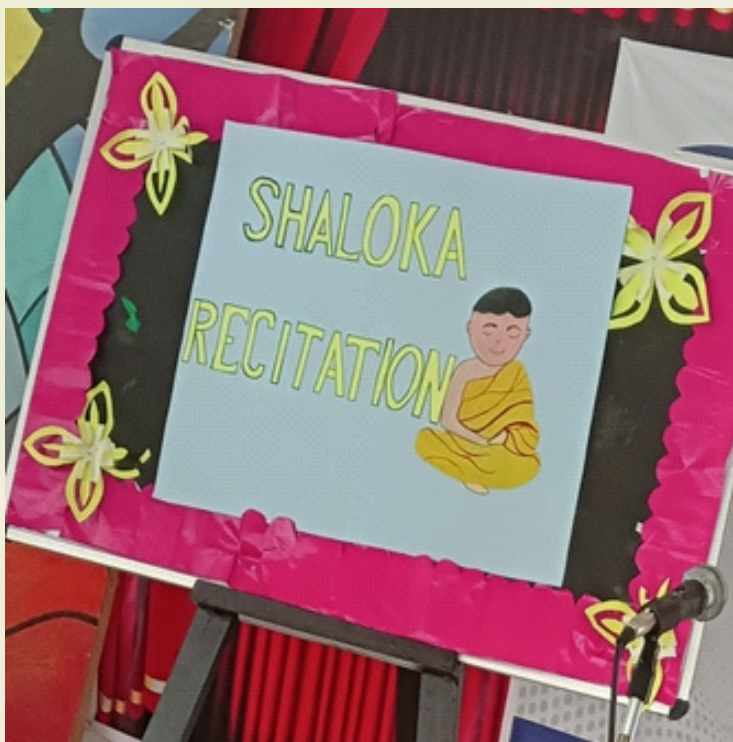

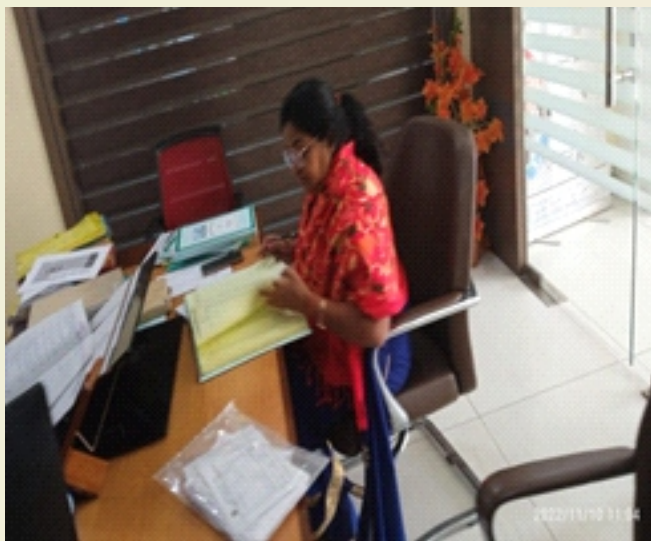
GOLD MEDAL IN DISTRICT LEVEL COMPETITION

My name is Ytansh Sharma.

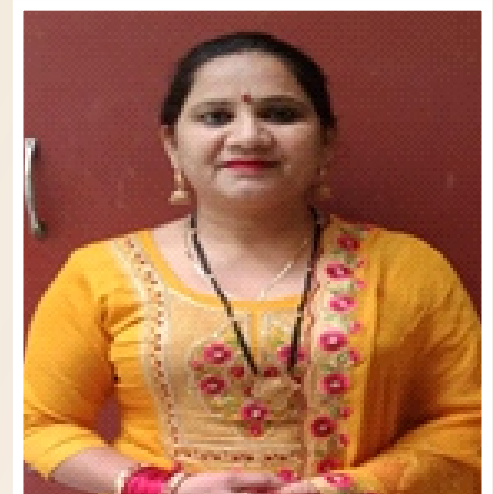
