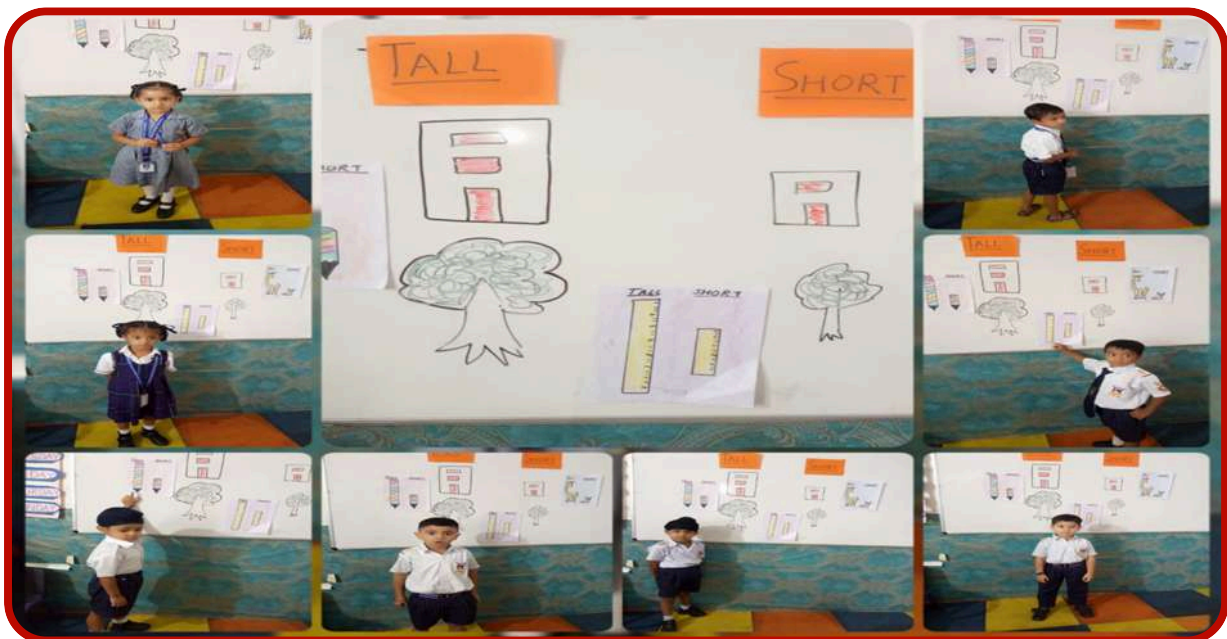
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TALL AND SHORT ACTIVITY

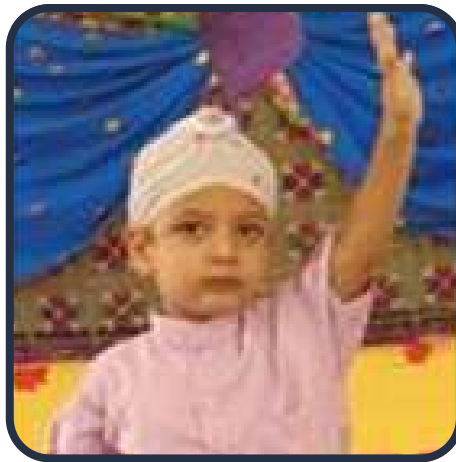


Competition gives people incentive to show up at their best, motivate them to push through plateaus and put in all the extra work to really hone in their singing.
